




The art of portrait can be made in a painting, a photograph, a sculpture, or any other artistic representation of a person (usually), in which the face and its expressions, as well emotions, are predominant. We can find artist evidences of portraits throughout our history of art since the 9th millennium BC, in the the Pre-Pottery Neolithic culture period.

All humans have different faces and also different expressions. Each face can reveal a different mood or mark made by the time or even a “mask” when assuming a role in a society. Each of these famous personalities in Adélia’s works have distinct talents and different faces, as they also disclose different emotions. However to understand better what each face means to us, we need to understand what it is a face. We also need to understand why faces have different expressions and emotions.

What is a face? A face it is a medium of self-presentation, expression and communication. A face can play a fundamental role in our daily lives and culture. Each face has a facial expression. The facial expression can be voluntary or involuntary.

The facial expression it is universal and it is combination of human emotions. These Human emotions are an unconscious biopsychosocial reaction. A micro-expression is a facial expression that only lasts for a short moment. These universal emotions are: disgust, anger, fear, sadness, happiness, contempt, surprise, amusement, embarrassment, anxiety, guilt, pride, relief, contentment, pleasure, and shame.






